Donate Your Solar Eclipse Glasses to School Children in Asia and South America

Like the rest of the U.S., Gabriel's staff eagerly anticipated the solar eclipse that crossed the country on August 21, 2017. Despite the clouds at our peak coverage, we all loved watching the moon cover the sun for a few hours.



Gabriel has now teamed up with Astronomers Without Borders (AWB) to send our used solar glasses to schools in Asia and South America for the next eclipse in 2019. Our Chicago headquarters is an official Glasses Collection Center, so we will accept donations of used glasses from anyone in the area before sending them to AWB at the end of September.

If you live or work near our headquarters (1421 N. Elston, Chicago), feel free to drop off the glasses at our reception desk from 8am - 5:30pm. There is a collection box by our side door for evening and weekend donations.

You can also bring your glasses to donate if you're planning to attend our Open House on September 7th.
